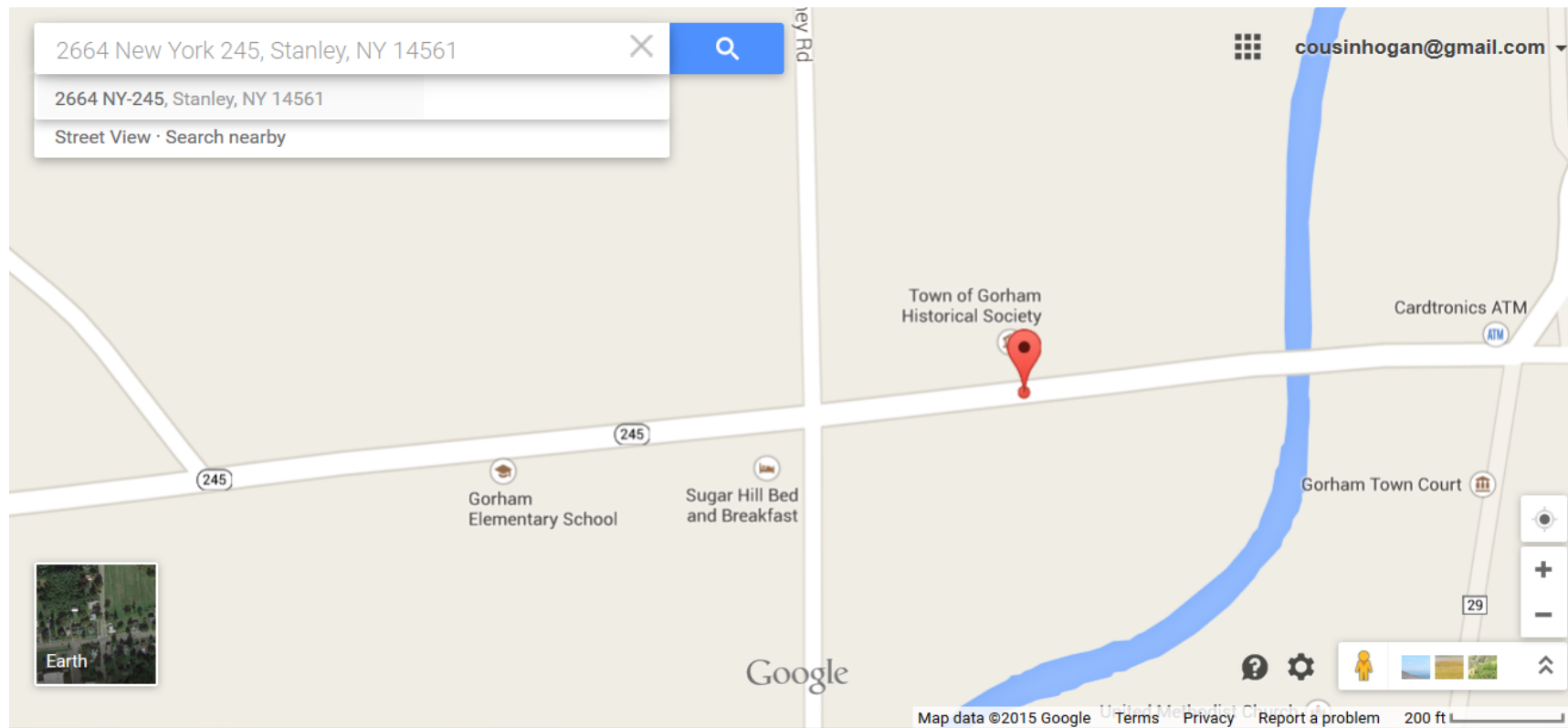

Why use maps for genealogy?

➤ Research

- Aids in understanding where to look for records (watch out for boundary changes)
- Can lead to finding ancestral home
- If you have a lot of data (all Smiths in a county), can help with analysis

➤ Sharing

- Visual format may be more appealing to some rather than facts & narratives.

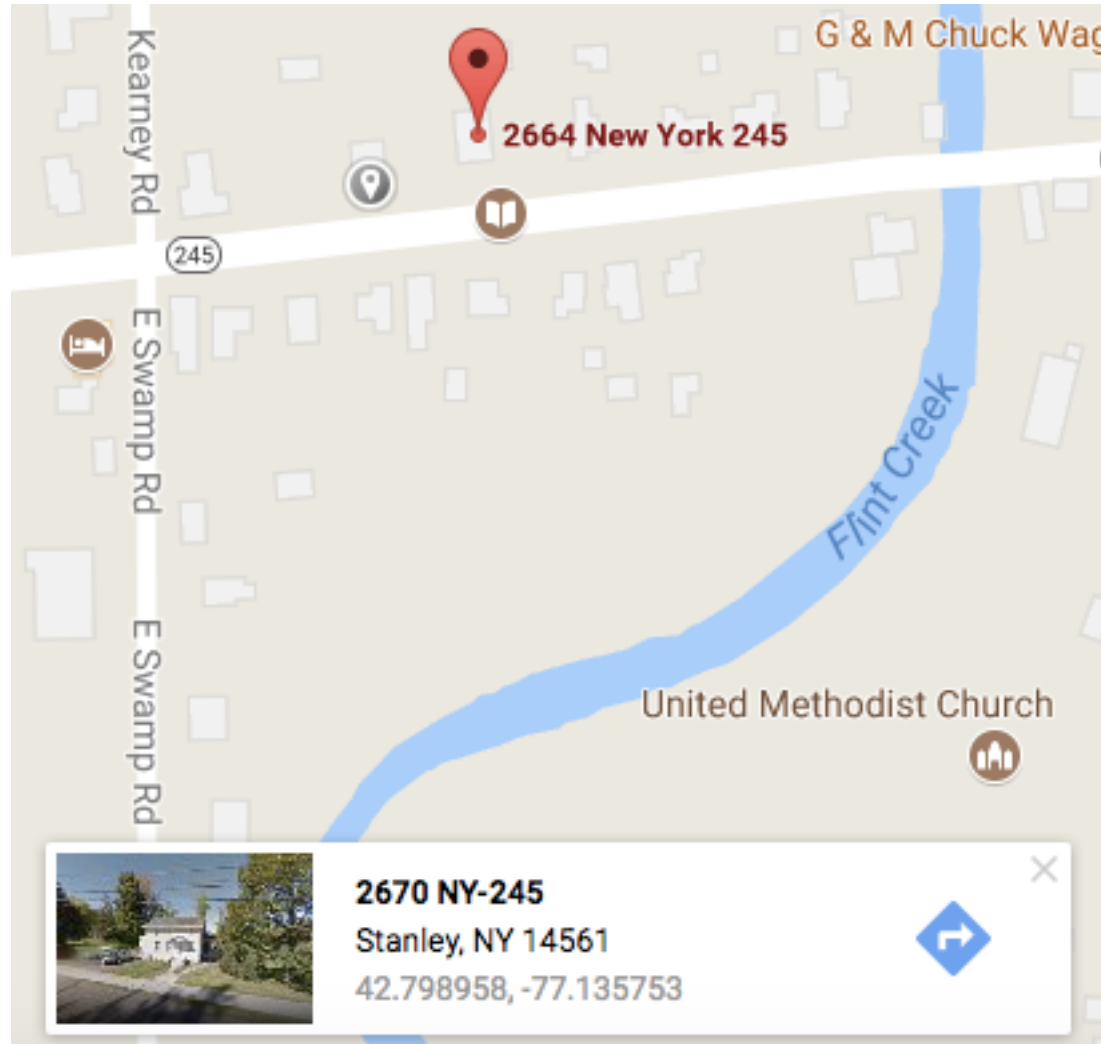

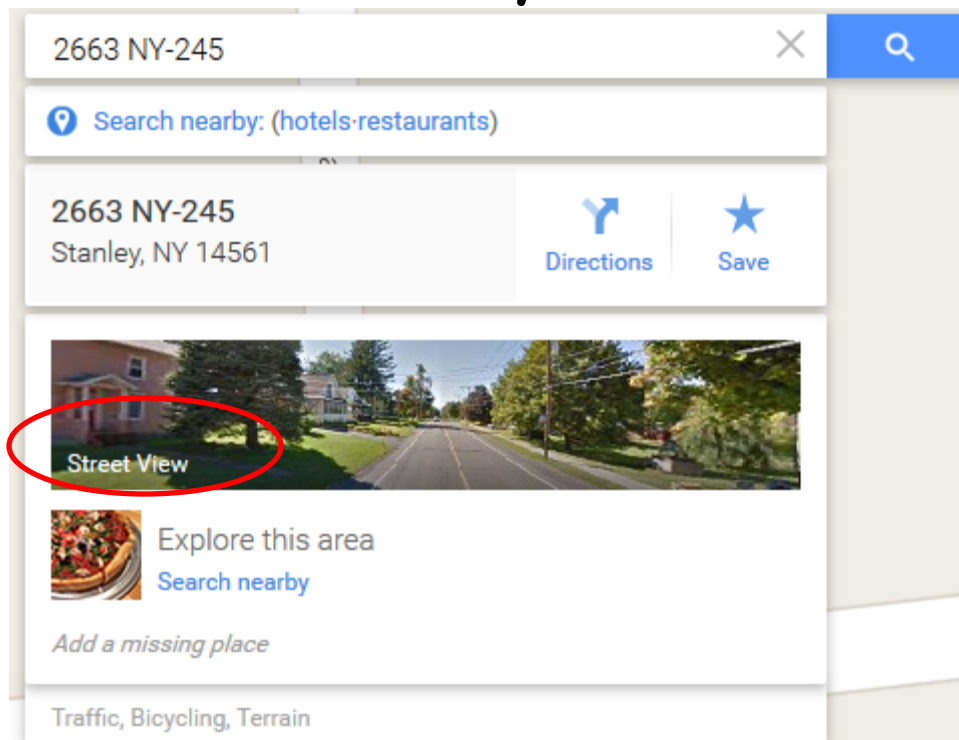


Google Maps - features

- Click on **Street View** to see interactive panoramic view (contemporary) of ancestral community
 - Click on  pegman icon to displays streets in blue which have been filmed for Street View
- Click on **Nearby** & enter something like cemeteries, churches, pizza, etc.

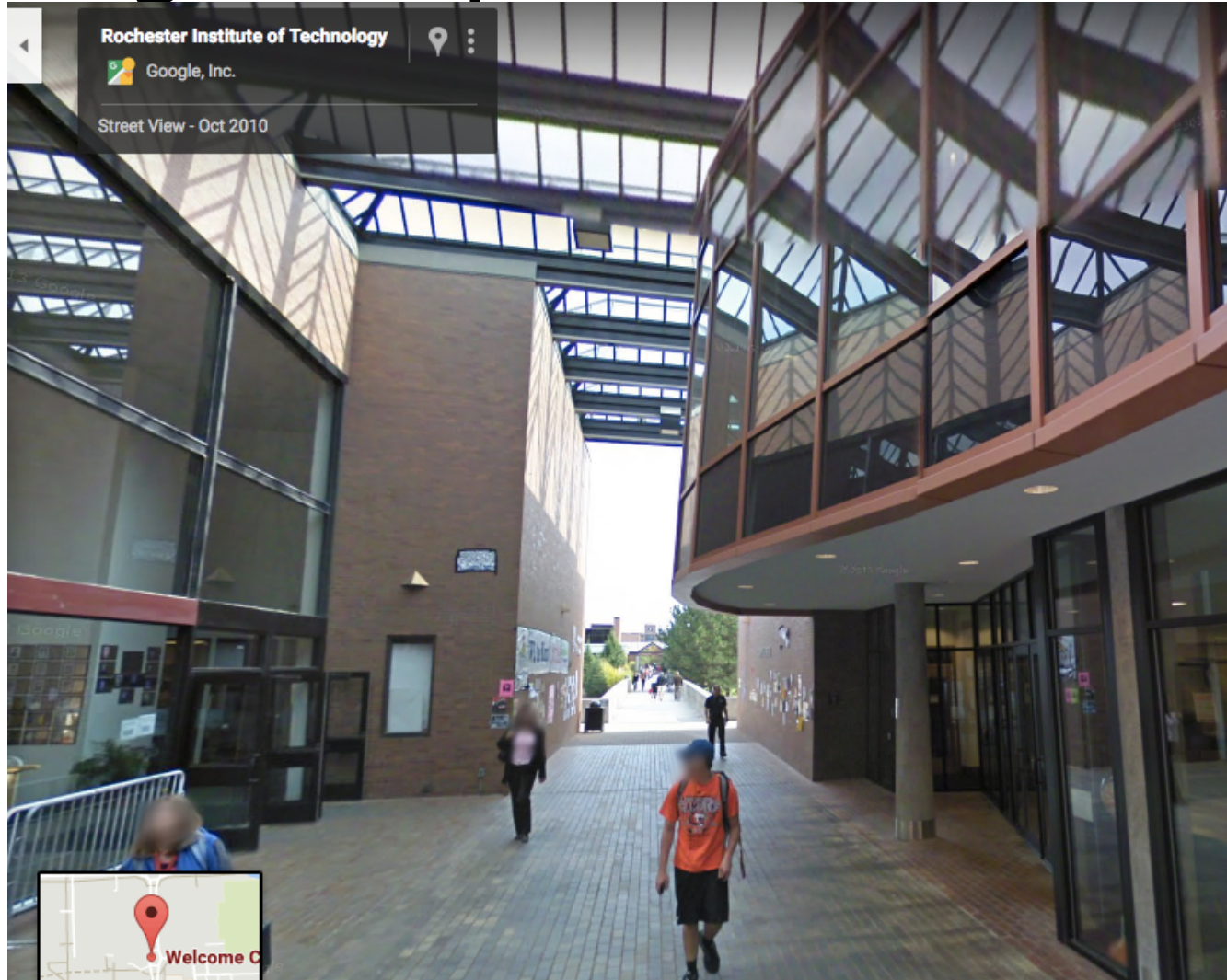

Google Maps - Street View

Two ways to shift view sideways:

- Click on arrow point/head of the  compass icon to shift view 90° clockwise or counter clockwise (90° per click).
 - Click on the center of the compass icon to orient view toward North.
- Hovering the cursor over image displays an arrow . Click and hold left mouse button while dragging the mouse to the left or right.

Google Maps - Street View

How to "walk down the road":

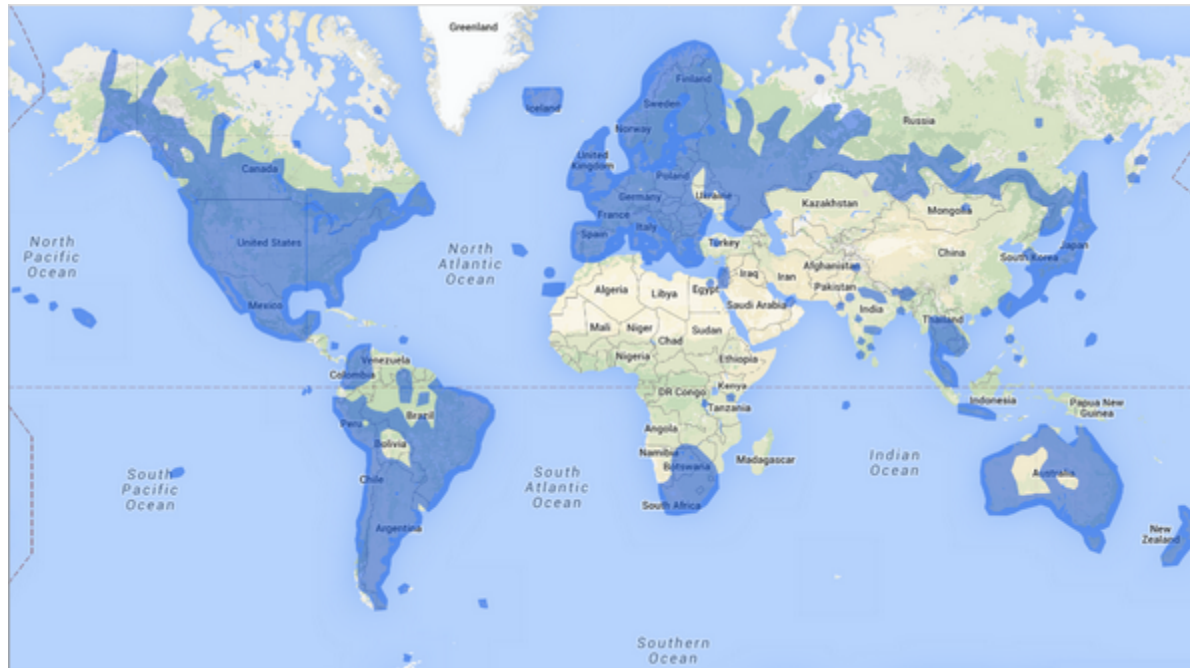
- Hovering the cursor over the road displays an arrow . Clicking the left mouse button advances view along the road.
 - Distance advanced depends on how far down the road you place the cursor.
- To jump to a different street, click a blue highlighted street in the preview window in the bottom left.

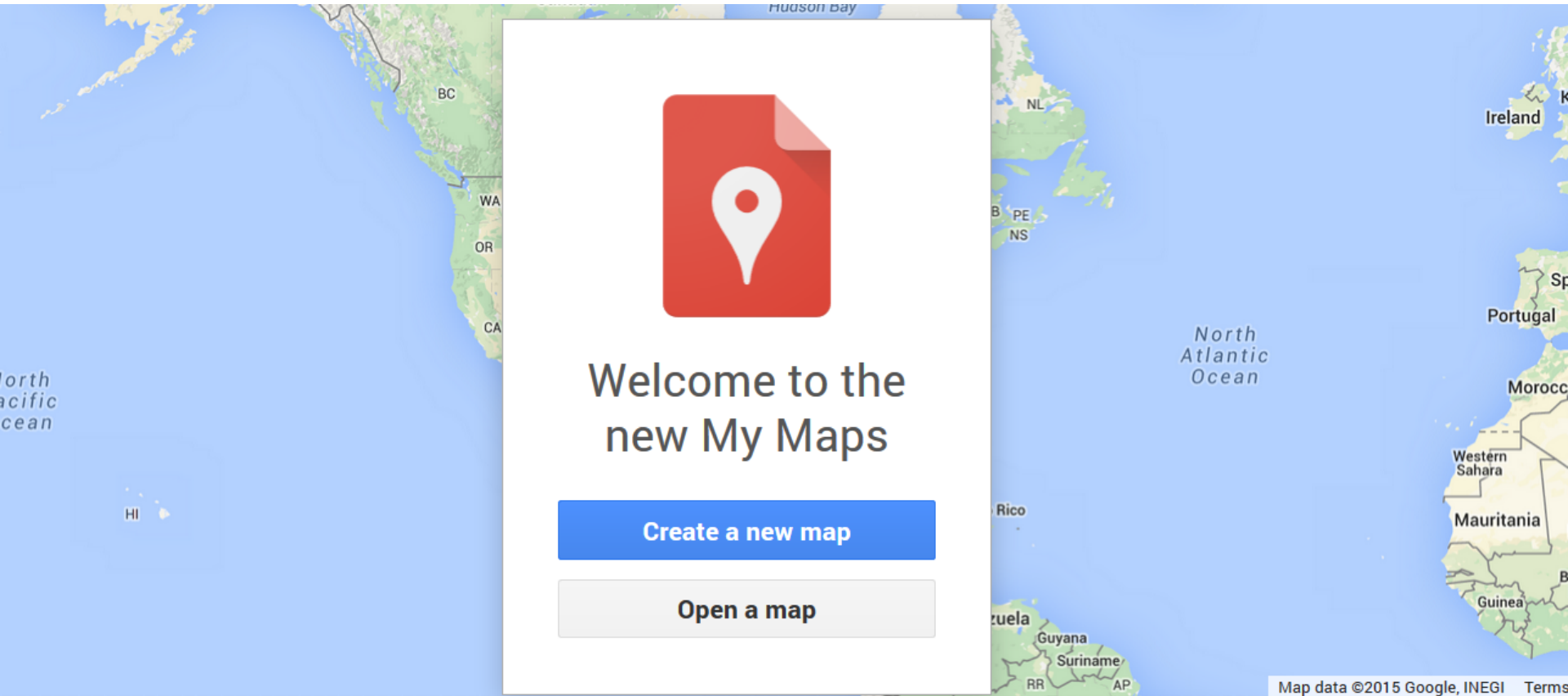
Google My Maps - features

- Share your map like you do a Google Doc.
- Use different colors to make parts of your map stand out.
- Label your features directly on the map.
- Import locations from a spreadsheet.
- Organize your places with layers.

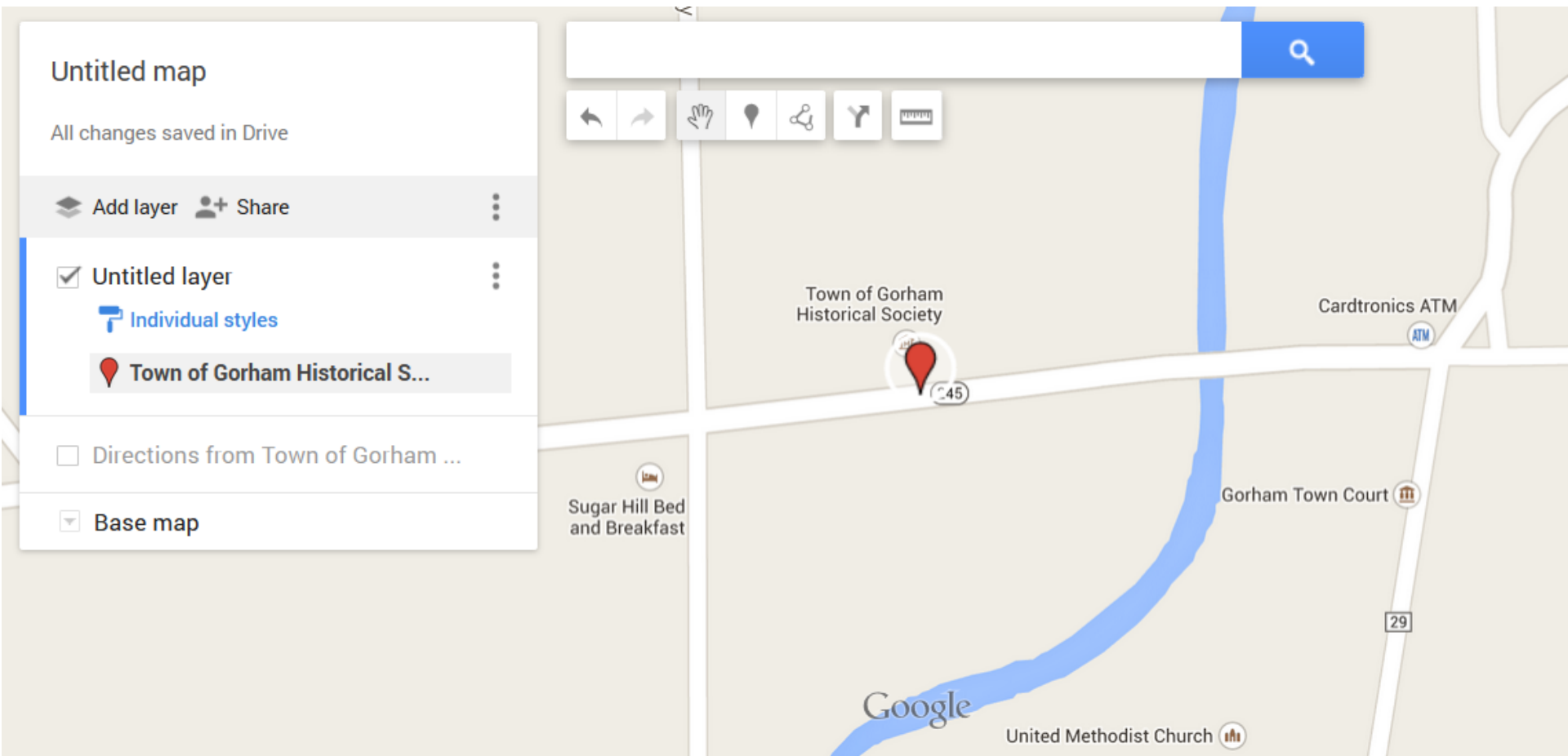

My Maps - Create a basic map

- Click on **Create a new map**
- Click on **Untitled Map**
- Enter a title & description
- Go to desired location
 - Enter a street address or GPS coordinates (ex, 42.79870, -77.14060) into the search box
 - Panning with the mouse
 - Zooming options: +/- on screen, mouse scroll wheel, mouse double clicking

My Maps - Create a basic map



My Maps - Add placemarks

- Click on **Add Marker** ( pin icon)
- Position cursor on desired location & click
 - Enter name and description

OR




- Search for an address
- Click on green placemark to add to map (changes color)
- Click on the placemark, then click **Edit**
 - Enter name and description

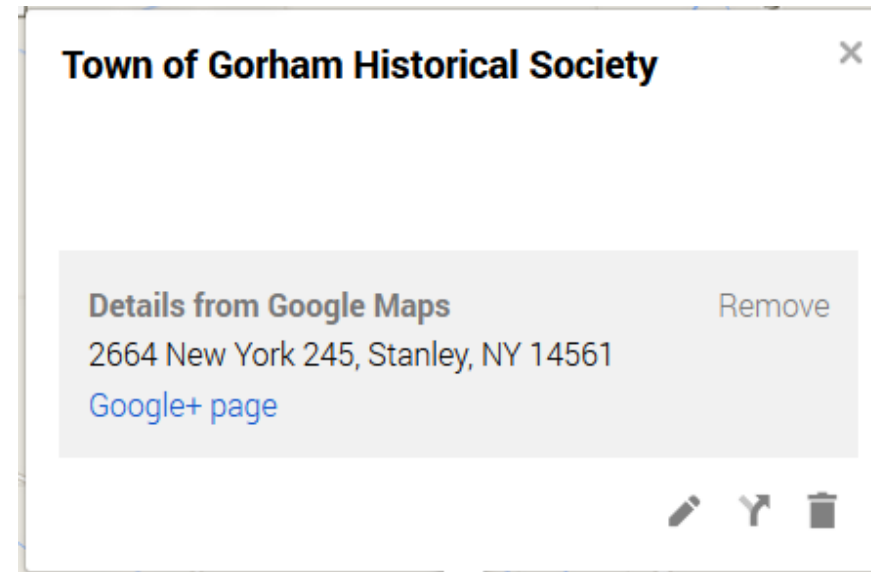
My Maps - Add placemarks



Create placemarks for locations of events in your family's history:

- Births
- Marriages
- Deaths
- Residences
- Ports
- Businesses
- Churches
- Schools
- Military battles or bases
- Others

My Maps - Modify placemarks


- Click on placemark ()
 - To request directions ()
 - To delete placemark ()




- Click on **Edit** ()
 - Can modify title, description, and add photos or videos ()



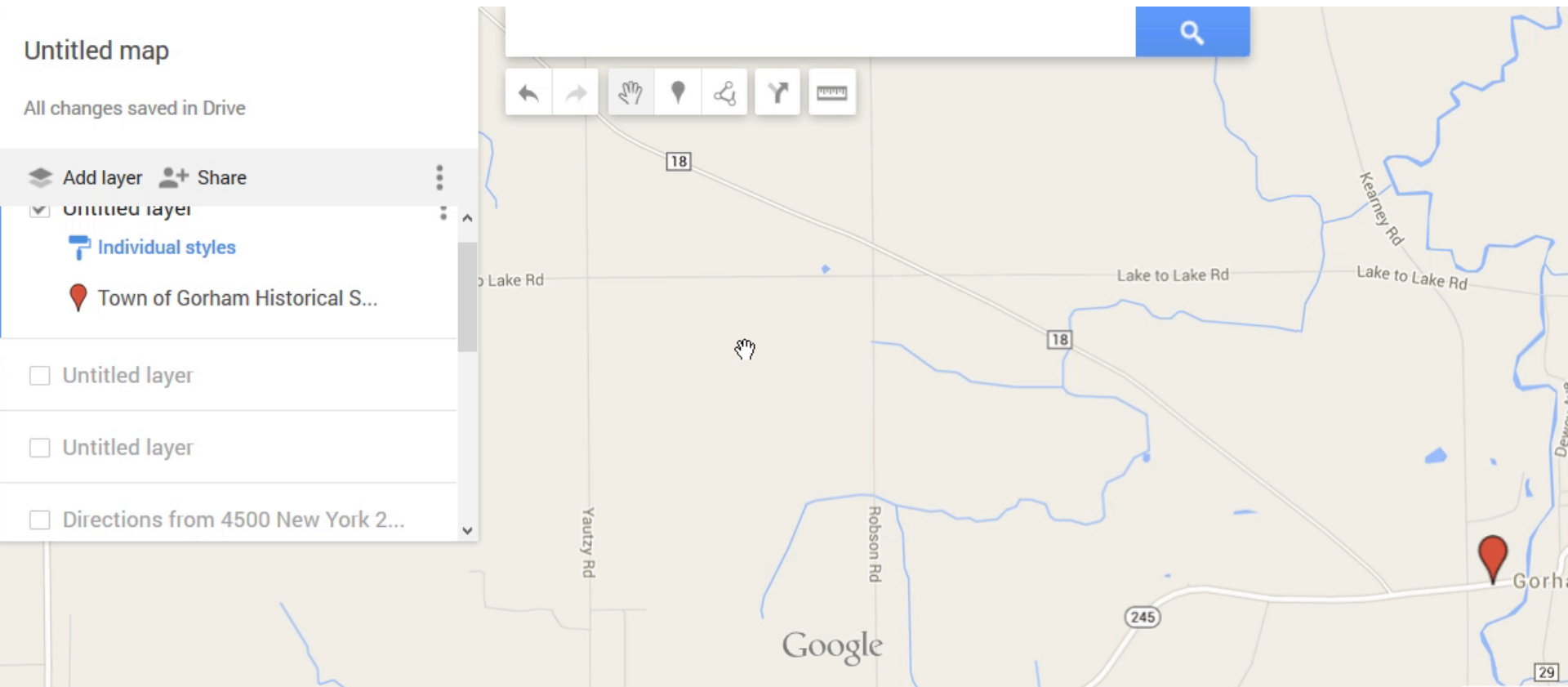
My Maps - Add lines

- Click on Draw a Line ( polygon icon)
- Select from:
 - Add line or shape
 - For straight lines or shapes with straight sides
 - Add driving route
 - A line between 2 points follows streets or roads
 - Add biking route
 - Add walking route

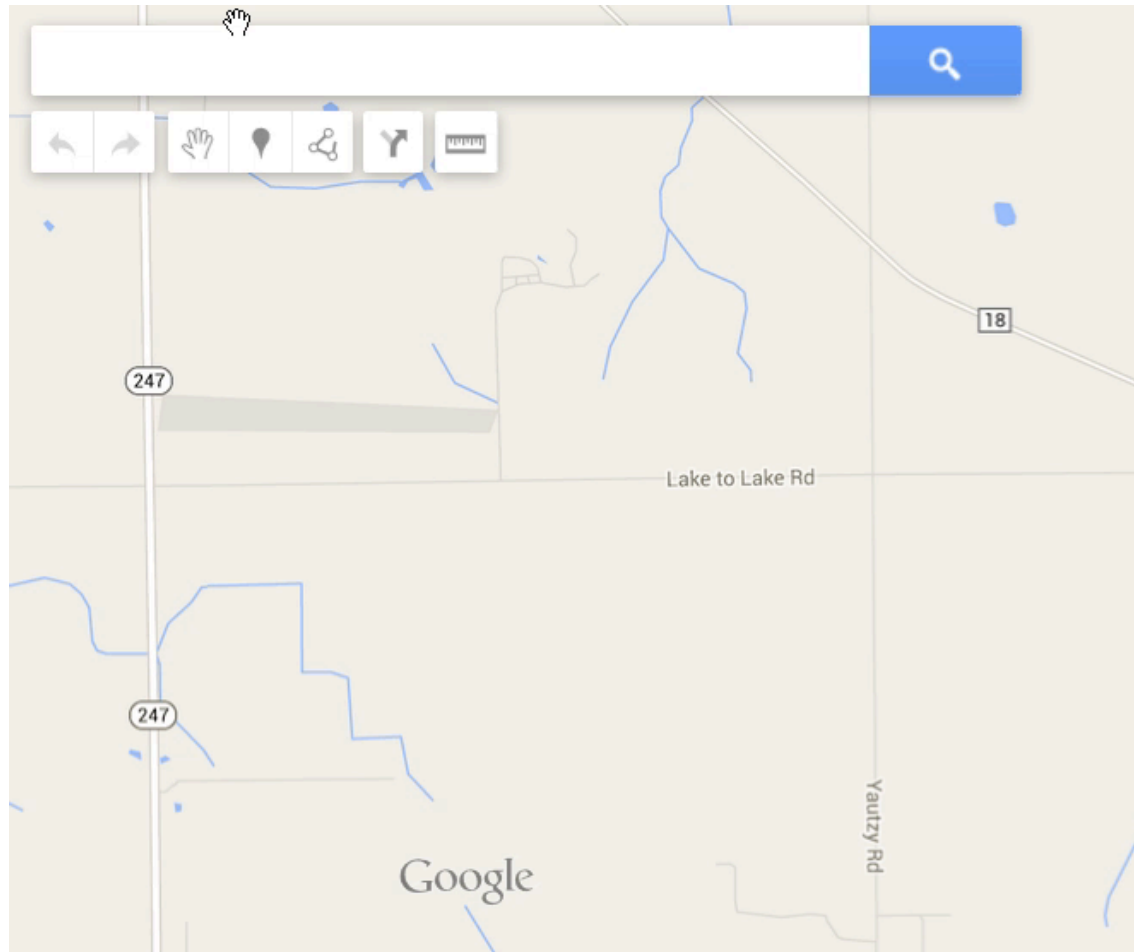
My Maps - To add a straight line

- Click on **Draw a Line** ( polygon icon)
- Select **Add line or shape**
- Position cursor at starting point & click
- Move cursor to draw the line
- At each turn, click once
- Double click to finish line
- To adjust a line segment, position cursor over circle on line segment & drag
- To give a line a name and description, click on the line & click **Edit**

My Maps - Customize Objects

➤ Click on the object listed in the panel on the left



➤ Click on the paint bucket icon

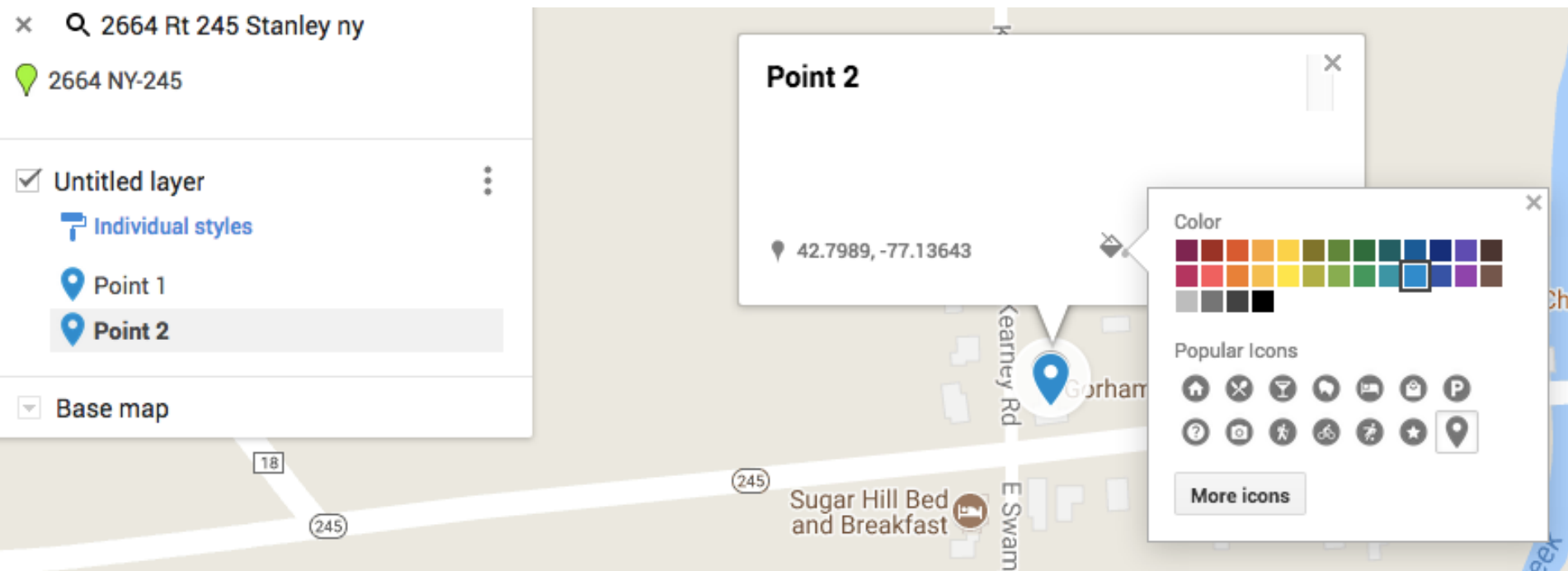
➤ Choose colors & shapes for placemarks

➤ Ready-made or custom

➤ Choose colors & widths for lines

➤ Choose color, transparency, & border width for shapes

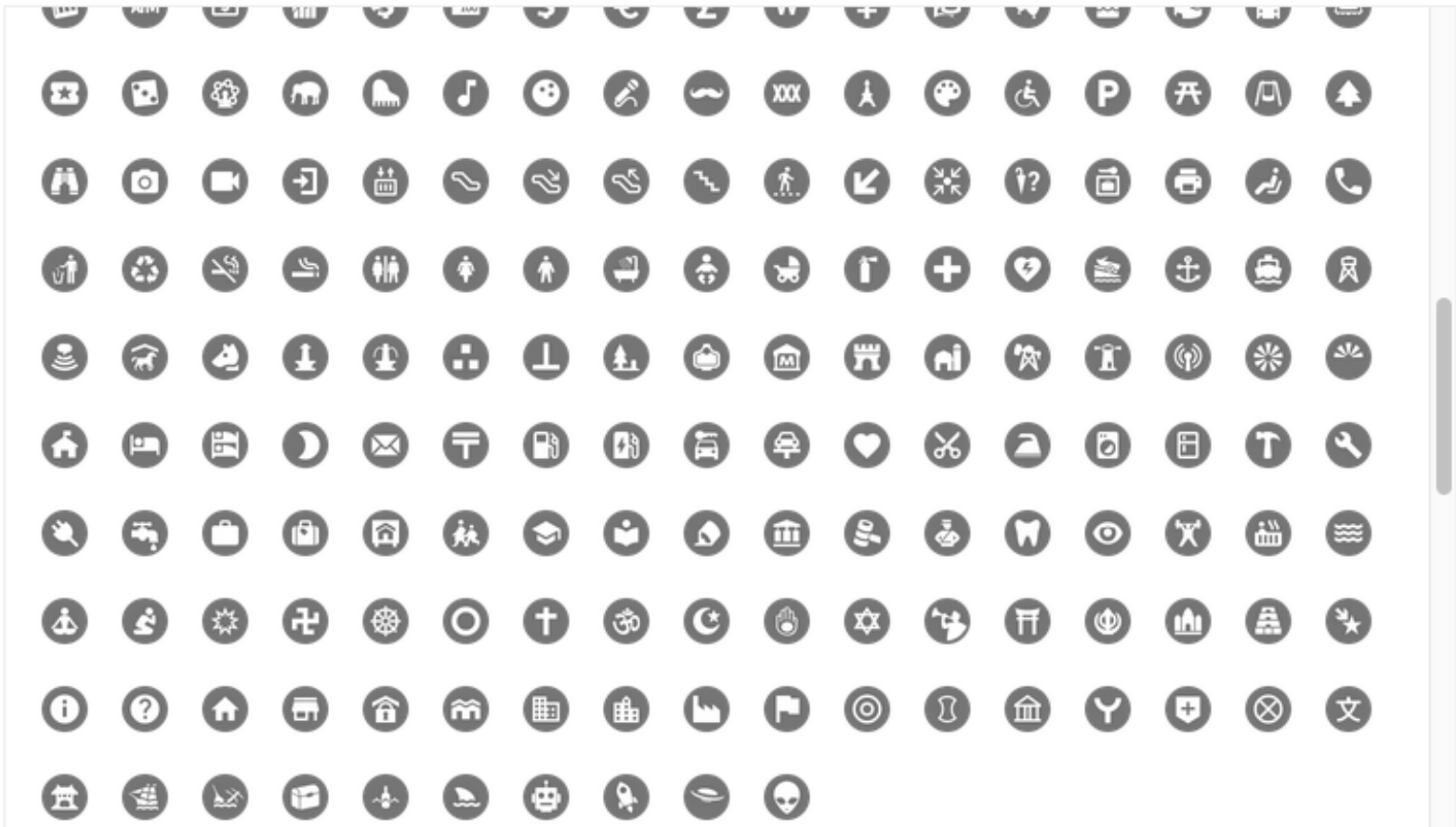

My Maps - Add Photos or Videos

- Click on the placemarker to be modified
- Click on **Edit** (pencil icon)
- Click the camera icon
- Enter photo or video URL or search
- Click **Save**

My Maps - Base Map

- A Base Map is the map provided by My Maps (without any of your customizations)
- Using the Base Map, you add custom objects in 1 or more "Layers"
- Choose 1 of the 9 styles for your Base Map which include default, satellite, and terrain (topo)
 - Scroll to the bottom of the panel on the left
 - Click the drop-down arrow left of "Base Map"
 - Click on any of the 9 thumbnails of styles

My Maps - Layers

- By default, all of your custom objects will be created in 1 layer (you don't have to think about layers)
- However you can create multiple layers to separate different categories of objects which can be viewed together or independently
 - Examples of possible layers: Family A, Family B, churches, schools, property boundaries, generations, etc

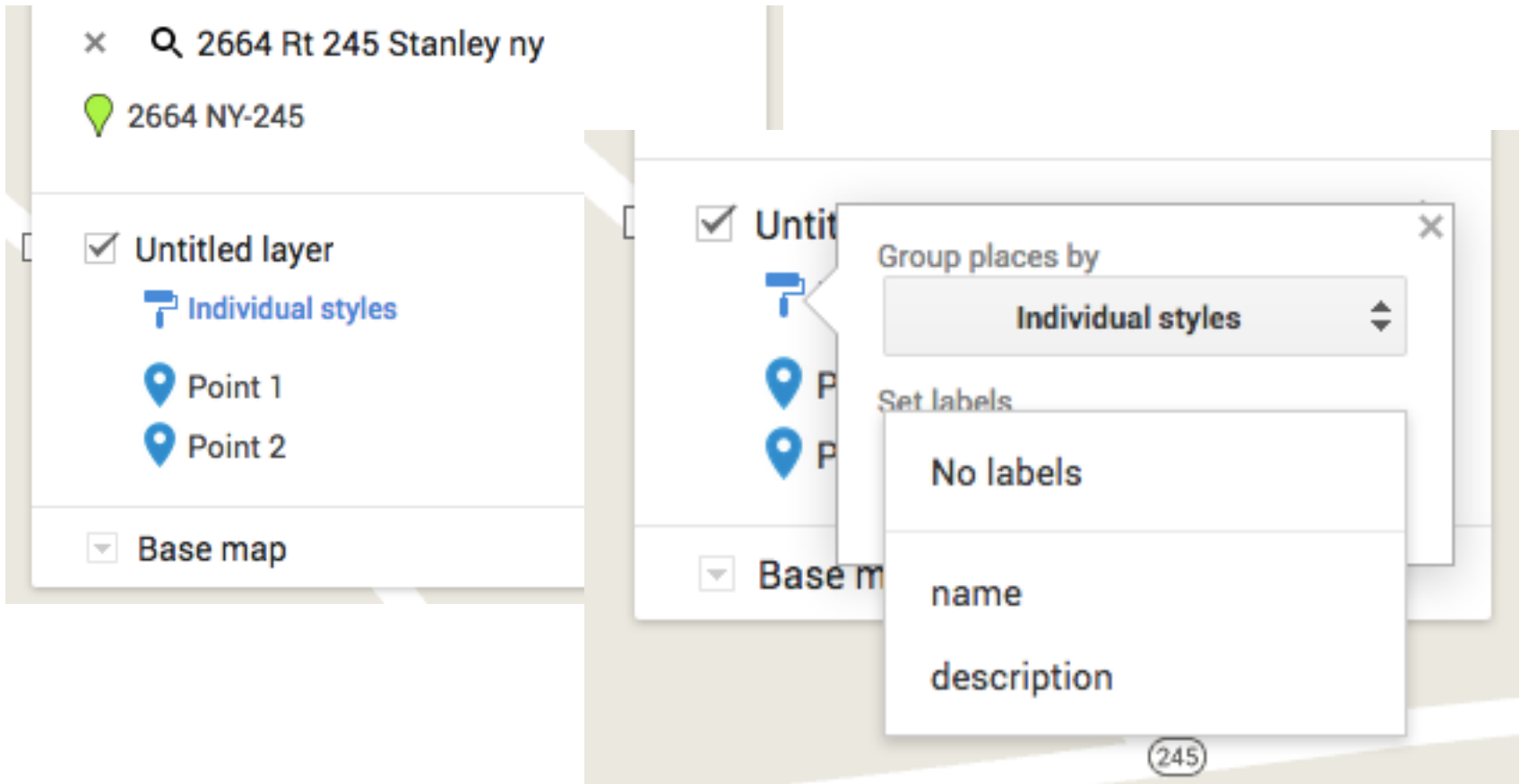
My Maps - Layers

- In panel on the left
- Click on **Add Layer**
- Double click on **Untitled Layer** & edit the name
- Check the box next to your layer
 - While layer is checked, new objects are part of that layer

My Maps - Add Labels

- On the panel on the left, select the layer for which you want to display labels
- Click on **Individual styles**
- Under **Set labels**, click arrows for drop-down menu
 - Click on **Name**
 - The title of all objects of the layer will be displayed on the map
 - Click on **No labels**
 - No labels will be displayed for all objects of the layer

My Maps - Add Labels



My Maps - Import Spreadsheet Data

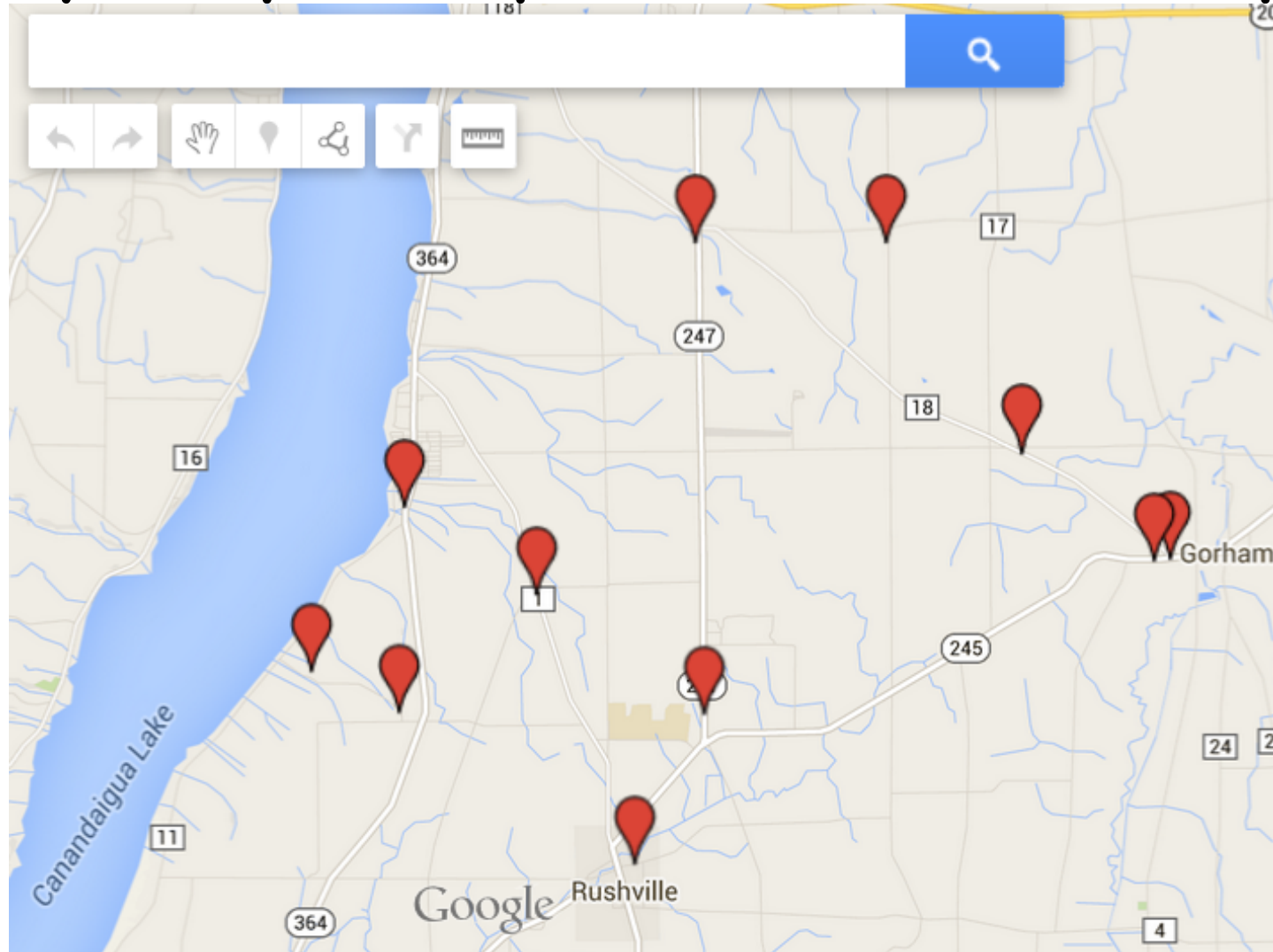
- Add a layer or choose an empty layer
- Click on **Import**
- Choose the spreadsheet or CSV file to be imported
- Choose column containing addresses
- Choose column containing placemark title

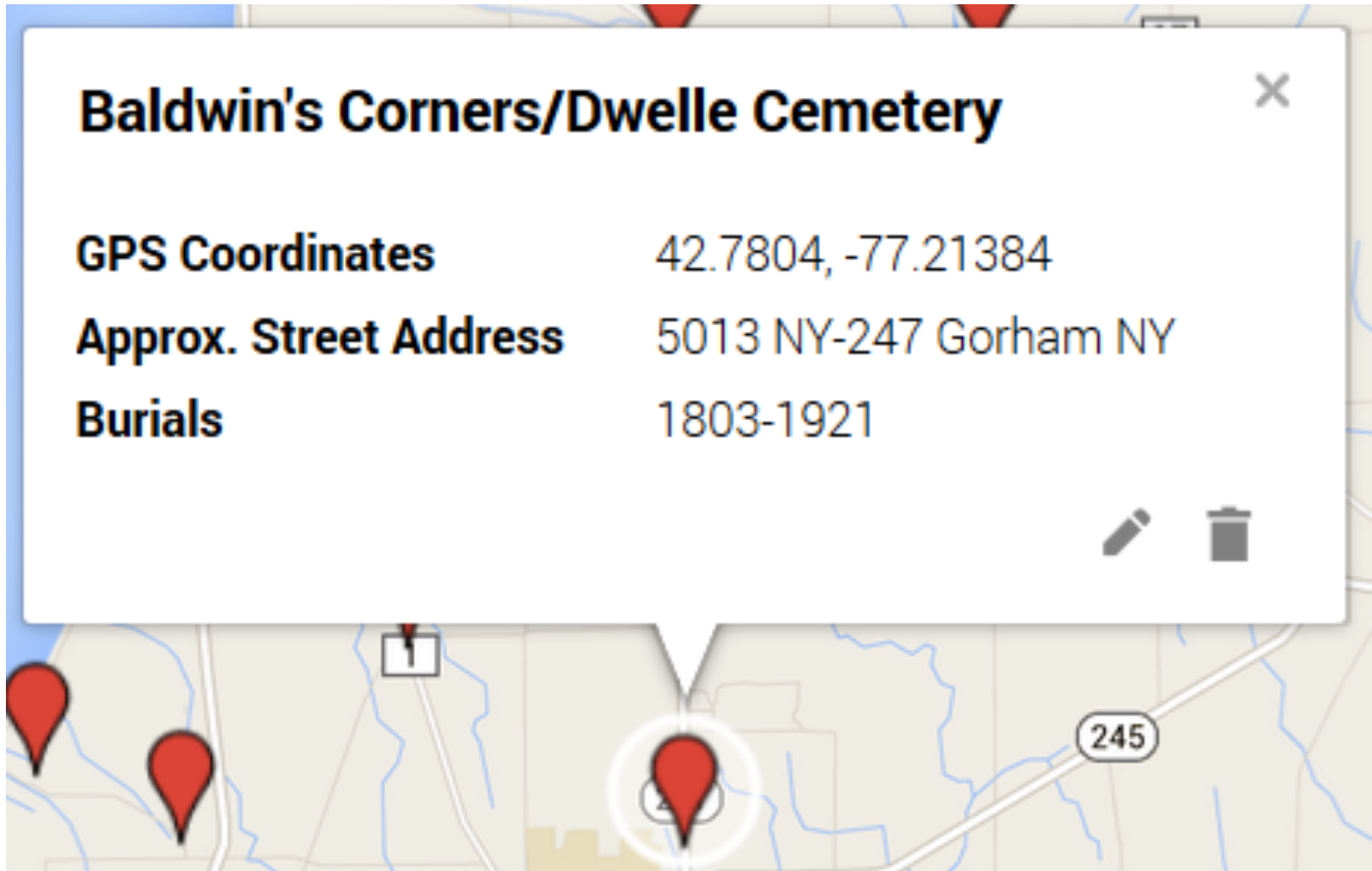

Sidebar - Spreadsheets on the Cheap

- [LibreOffice](#), [Google Docs](#)
- Create a CSV file in a text editor
 - CSV stands for Comma Separated Values
 - Example:
 - Pioneer Cemetery,2700 Rt 245,Gorham NY
 - New Gorham Cemetery,2800 Rt 245,Gorham NY
 - Save file
 - Rename file to .csv (turn on display of file extensions)

Sidebar - Sources of Address

- House number & street name:
 - US Census 1880 - 1940
 - NY State Census 1905 - 1925
 - City Directories
 - Others: death notices, civil registrations, probate files, ...
 - In Google Maps (not My Maps), click desired location to yield street address (& gps)
 - <http://www.gps-coordinates.net/> can convert gps to street address and vice versa

My Maps - Sharing

- By default, My Maps are only viewable by owner
- To share (base map plus selected layers)
 - Click on **Share** in the panel on the left
 - At **Invite people:**, enter email addresses of recipients & click **Done**

OR

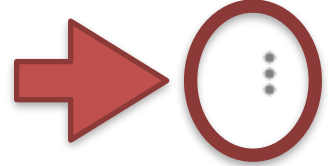
- Post to social media by selecting icon
- Select visibility options - **Who has access**



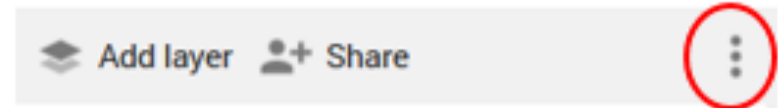

My Maps - Embed on a website

- Click on **Share** in the panel on the left
- Change **Who has access to Public on the web** & click **Save**
- Click **Done**
- Click on map icon, 
- Click on **Embed on my site**
- Copy the code & paste into your webpage source code

My Maps - Export to KML

- KML - Keyhole Markup Language. A file standard for interchange of map data. (Similar to the way GEDCOM is a file standard for the interchange of genealogical data.)
- Click on map icon,
- Click on **Export to KML**
- Choose single layer or entire map
- Click **Download** & where to save file
- You can also import KML files into My Maps, see <https://support.google.com/mymaps/answer/3024937>

Braul Family History

This map plots the places of settlement and the migrations of members of the Braul family. The family's history is part of the 16th century Anabaptist movement in the Low Lands (Belgium/ Netherlands), and of the Mennonite community in Polish-Prussian, Russia, Paraguay and Canada. Zoom-in by scrolling or by using the bar on the left. Click "Satellite" view for satellite photos of any point on the map (also zoom-in). Click icons for a commentary.
